Voters' Bill of Rights

- ★ **YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO VOTE** in the election, if you are in line by 7 p.m. Polling places are open from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Election Day.
- ★ **YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO VOTE EVEN IF YOU DO NOT HAVE IDENTIFICATION** with you on Election Day. If you do not have any form of identification, you must sign a form under oath swearing or affirming that you are the person identified on your voter certificate.
- ★ **YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO VOTE BY PROVISIONAL BALLOT**, even if you are a first time voter who registered by mail and you do not have identification or you did not include a copy of your identification with your application.
- ★ **YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO RECEIVE ASSISTANCE**, if you cannot read English, you are blind, or disabled, from anyone you choose except your employer, your employer's agent, or an officer or representative of your union. This rule only applies if a federal candidate is on the ballot.
- ★ **IF YOU ARE 75 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER, OR YOU ARE DISABLED AND REQUIRE ASSISTANCE IN VOTING, YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO ASSISTANCE** between the hours of 9:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. on Election Day, without waiting in line.
- ★ **YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO VOTE IN YOUR OLD PRECINCT**, if you move to a different county or city after the fifth Monday before Election Day.
- ★ **YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO RECEIVE A REPLACEMENT BALLOT**, if you make a mistake or "spoil" your ballot and have not cast your ballot by returning the spoiled ballot to a poll officer.
- ★ **NO PERSON MAY CAMPAIGN, TRY TO INFLUENCE YOUR VOTE, ASK YOU TO SIGN A PETITION, OR SOLICIT YOU IN ANY WAY** when you are standing in line within 25 feet of a polling place.
- ★ **YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO VOTE WITH A CONVICTION ON YOUR RECORD**, if you have completed your sentence, including any period or probation or parole, and have registered to vote since that time.
- ★ **YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO BRING YOUR CHILD UNDER THE AGE OF 18 INTO THE VOTING BOOTH** as long as they are not disruptive or interfere with the voting process or operate the voting machine.
- ★ **YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO VOTE DURING THE WORK DAY**, as long as you give notice, you have up to two hours to vote, unless you begin work after 9:00 a.m. or end work at 5:00 p.m.

The Urban League of Greater Atlanta - Young Professionals (ULGA-YP) serve the metro Atlanta area through social and community activism. Part of the organization's mission is to increase civic and political knowledge and involvement in the community ULGA-YP serves. Your vote is your voice. It is your opportunity to express your opinion on how local, state and federal government operate, hold leaders accountable, and speak out on issues that matter to you. We hope this document will aid in helping metro Atlantans navigate the political process and make informed decisions.

POSITIONS UP FOR ELECTION

GEORGIA STATE SENATE:

The upper house of the Georgia General Assembly, which makes general rules and laws for the state of Georgia.

GEORGIA STATE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

The lower house of the Georgia General Assembly, which set the state's annual operating budget and address state priorities.

STATE BALLOT MEASURES:

Proposed rules or laws to be approved or rejected by voters.

SUPERIOR COURT JUDGE:

Presides over trials in felony cases, divorce, equity, and property cases.

STATE COURT JUDGE:

Presides over misdemeanor violations, including traffic cases, and adjudicate civil actions except in cases in which the superior court has exclusive jurisdiction.

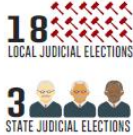
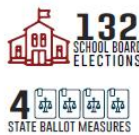
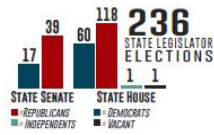
GEORGIA SUPREME COURT:

The highest court in the State of Georgia. Its rulings are not subject to further review by another court, and it manages lower courts and the rules of the court system.

SCHOOL BOARD:

School boards are the education watchdog for their communities, ensuring that students get the best education for the tax dollars spent.

MAJOR STATE BALLOT MEASURE TO WATCH

OPPORTUNITY SCHOOL DISTRICT (OSD):

If approved by the Georgia electorate in November, the OSD would take over supervision, management and operation of failing schools. Schools that earn an "F" for three (3) consecutive years according to the state's accountability system are eligible for the new district. This statewide district would be managed by a superintendent appointed and supervised by Georgia's governor and could take control of up to 20 schools per year up to a maximum of 100 at a time.

WHO CAN VOTE AND VALID VOTER ID INFORMATION

WHO CAN VOTE:

- ★ CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES
- ★ LEGAL RESIDENT OF THE COUNTY IN WHICH YOU INTEND TO VOTE
- ★ VOTER MUST BE AT LEAST 17.5 YEARS OF AGE AT THE TIME OF REGISTRATION AND 18 AT THE TIME OF THE ELECTION
- ★ CONVICTED FELONS MAY VOTE UPON COMPLETION OF HIS OR HER SENTENCE. THIS INCLUDES PRISON TIME, PAROLE, PROBATION AND RESTITUTION

VALID FORMS OF IDENTIFICATION INCLUDE:

- ★ ANY VALID STATE OR FEDERAL GOVERNMENT ISSUED PHOTO ID, INCLUDING A FREE ID CARD ISSUED BY YOUR COUNTY REGISTRAR'S OFFICE OR THE GEORGIA DEPARTMENT OF DRIVER SERVICES (DDS)
- ★ A GEORGIA DRIVER'S LICENSE, EVEN IF EXPIRED
- ★ VALID EMPLOYEE PHOTO ID FROM ANY BRANCH, DEPARTMENT, AGENCY, OR ENTITY OF THE U.S. GOVERNMENT, GEORGIA, OR ANY COUNTY, CITY, BOARD, AUTHORITY OR OTHER ENTITY OF THIS STATE
- ★ VALID U.S. PASSPORT ID, U.S. MILITARY PHOTO ID, OR TRIBAL PHOTO ID
- ★ VOTER IDENTIFICATION CARD (CAN BE ISSUED AT ANY COUNTY REGISTRAR'S OFFICE OR DDS OFFICE FREE OF CHARGE)

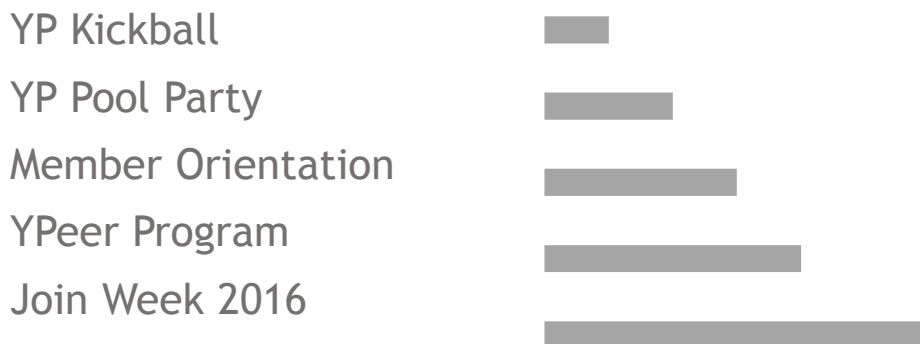

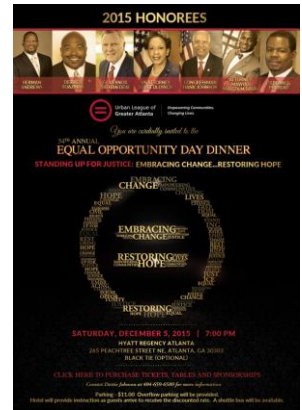
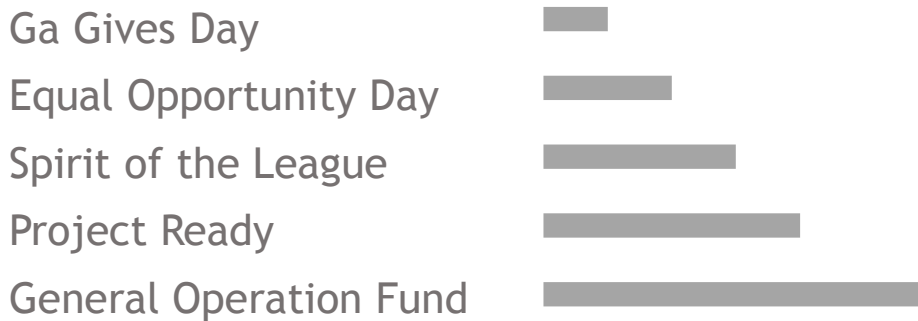
